
through, and Stroll Amelia Island


ES GABEYOND Pour duries with Shelley and Jeff Hirshberg

Shelley and Jeff Hirshberg have fostered a lifelong appreciation of the arts, influencing everything from how they furnish their homes to how they plan their travel around the globe. This couple has honed an eclectic taste for design that eschews classification boundaries. Shelley explained, "We seek out "interesting relationships with the art and its creator; we enjoy learning how culture, gender and a sense of place influence art and sculpture." They appreciate multiple forms of artistic expression: paint, ink, multimedia, sculpted glass, clay, and metal. Their art collection includes a variety of work created in disparate places and times, yet each

piece complements and enhances the whole. The Hirshbergs know that good design knows no boundaries.

This home was built to entertain and showcase how their collection integrates early works with newer techniques, in a seamless blend of color and texture. The contemporary design and furnishings create a neutral backdrop. At the center of the house is a display wall with spotlights and audiovisual capability, acting as a hub in this home with art displayed throughout. Early acquisitions from their home in New York were relocated to this new home and include favorite pieces created by Shirley

Rosenthal, Catherine Parker, Harriet Greif, and Rachel Ostrow.

Shelley Hirshberg has a BA in Art History from Bucknell University, a Masters in Health Services Administration from the University of Wisconsin, and is a graduate of the Center for Entrepreneurial Leadership at the State University of New York in Buffalo. In 2014 Shelley completed a Leadership Coaching program at Georgetown University. She is currently a coach for the University at Buffalo School of Management's Center for Leadership and Organizational Effectiveness and the Executive MBA program and the Health Foundation of Western and Central New York. Shelley has volunteered her leadership expertise on numerous Boards and Executive Committees for health agencies in New York and recently joined the Board of Directors of Take Stock in Children of Nassau County. Jeff


Hirshberg earned a BA in Economics from Bucknell University, a Ph.D. in Medieval English literature, and an MBA from the University of Wisconsin. They built robust careers and raised three children in Buffalo, NY, where Jeff achieved his CPA and started a successful tax and estate planning practice.

Their earliest collected artwork is a pen and ink portrait, "Roman Ruins' by Harriet Greif, left to Shelley by her mother. The oldest piece in their collection is a hand-painted Tibetan Thangka from the early 20th century, given to them by Jeff's mother. Both Shelley and Jeff easily recall people and places that inspire their desire to have original art in their home. As a young girl growing up in Buffalo, Shelley remembers watching Harriet Greif and her husband, Seymour Drumlevich, painting landscapes in the upper flat of her parent's house.

Jeff's mother worked as an interior decorator near New York City, and he was often at city museums like the Museum of Modern Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, and the Met Cloisters.

In 2008, Shelley attended a professional conference at Amelia Island Plantation and fell in love with the natural beauty of Amelia Island. Soon after, they began taking family vacations to AIP and purchased two condos. Their decision to build a new home here came to fruition in 2021. They now live full-time in the Plantation. Since moving into their new home, they've been adding works from local artists in earnest. In northeast Florida the light is more intense and sustained, so even the art they relocated from the North shows somewhat differently. Several local artists, whose work has a contemporary fresh feel, are expanding the breadth of creative expression in the home.

Jarred Bishop's metal-working craft began decades ago, and his recent focus is sculpture created from aged 55-gallon steel drums. Jarred uses an axe to cut, fold, and shape metal, selecting weathered steel drums with interesting oxidation and aged finishes, and has completed 54 sculptures in this particular series. His sculptures in the Hirshbergs' home take a variety of shapes (female torsos, geometric shapes) and names (Caroline, Norepinephrine Deficiency, Moon Rock). The

Hirshbergs also acquired a sculpted torso named Jessica Lange, with a ballet-dancer form displayed on a metal stand. Jarred commented, "Jeff and Shelley have a very sophisticated taste in contemporary art, and it is a high compliment to have my work integrated into their beautiful collection." Jarred is represented by the Atlantic Contemporary Gallery, the Island Art Association, and is available at polarityartgallery@gmail.com.

Lisbeth Krawiecki started Fired Up Fernandina to sell pottery and ceramics that are functional and feature the organic beauty around us: sea life, frogs, trees, and other objects of nature. She has lived on Amelia Island since 2013 with a studio and kiln in her garage and a firing pit in her yard. Her unique style is eye-catching, using carving, slip, and sgraffito to decorate thrown pieces. Her work is seen at the Atlantic Contemporary Gallery, Island Art Association, and retail centers Coastal Cottage and Color It Green. "My newer work, a monochromatic totem, is now included on the Hirshbergs' showcase wall in one of multiple niche cut-outs," said Lis. Two wall installations done by Lis for their condominium were relocated and modified to find a new life in this new home.

Susi Sax has a studio at Blue Door Artists on Centre Street and her glass etchings of local birds, plants, and animals are seen at the Fernandina Beach Public Library and the Council on Aging. Susi works on commission for home doors and windows and can be reached at ssaxarts@gmail.com. Her ongoing creative work with paint, stain glass, and mosaics began decades ago, and Susi learned glass etching in a Dale Chihuly class over 16 years ago. The etching is painstakingly done; her original drawings create a pattern, then she brushes the clear glass with strokes of sand, water, and air to reveal the image. Susi commented, "It's nice that my Great Blue Heron with sea grapes is landing at the Hirshbergs'. It feels so at home with so many artistic friends."

Aaron Whitehouse and Todd Alexander have over three decades of combined experience as professional artists, and each resides in Fernandina. In November 2021, they opened The Atlantic Contemporary Gallery (theatlanticcontemporary.com) to showcase their work with other local and nationally-represented artists. Shelley and Jeff selected Aaron's large 75-by-60 mixed media painting with three-dimensional texture in neutral tones and a sculpture of blue-water hue resin made of upcycled driftwood. "The Hirshbergs allowed us to recommend locations for our work in their home. Their collection tells a story about who Shelley and Jeff are as individuals," they explained. The Atlantic Contemporary Gallery offers quarterly shows of new artwork. The next show is planned for April 23, 2022, but Todd and Aaron are always available by appointment.




Detail of Susi Sax *Great Blue Heron* etching on the Hirshbergs' front doors



What does it take to confess your deepest secrets?

Annie, Sondra, and Jo were the best of childhood friends, but they haven't seen each other in far too long. In Campfire Confessions (BooksFluent, March 8, 2022), the women reunite to embark on an adventure that is equal parts hilarious, dangerous, and enlightening.

Married to a minister in a small town, Annie's devoted her life to

raising four sons and volunteering wherever she's needed. Most people consider her a saint, but they don't know she's hiding a big secret. Sondra's married to one of the richest men in L.A. and she appears to have it all – a glitzy lifestyle, beauty, brains, and a successful career. But when a real estate deal blooms into an affair, she quickly realizes she's in over her head. Jo is four years sober and struggling through a divorce. After a one-night stand, she's forced to reckon with a lifetime of bad choices.

When Annie's secret finally catches up with her, Jo and Sondra rush to her side. Determined to find answers, they pry Annie away from her daily grind, escaping on a canoeing trip that turns into a soul-searching, death-defying adventure. Lost in the woods as one thing goes wrong after another, they find themselves sharing their deepest secrets around the campfire. But as each new revelation unfolds, one thing becomes clear: It will take more than a night of true confessions for the three of them to find their way back home.

KRISTINE OCHU is the founder of "The Night of a Woman's Soul – Creating Your Amazing Life" workshops and is a former Human Resource Executive with a Master of Arts in Industrial Relations from the University of Minnesota. She is a member of the Global Women's Club, Women in Film and Video New England, Harvard Square Script Writers, and community groups. Having previously written screenplays and a children's book, Kristine incorporates her love of nature and adventure into all her stories. A former log-rolling champion, she still log-rolls along with being an avid hiker, kayaker, and explorer.





Take Golf Seriously

urrounded as we are by world-class golf facilities, we forget there are thousands of other courses around the country. Most South Island residents took up the game in other places, be it their local muni long forgotten or a classic track such as Muirfield Village, Jack Nicklaus's famed course in Ohio. Such is the case of Amelia Island Plantation residents Dee and Joe Sullivan, former Muirfield Village residents. Each brings a unique history and experience to this golf corner of the world.

Joe Sullivan is a Korean War veteran as a member of the Army's 187th Regimental Combat Team, paratroopers, nicknamed the "Rakkasans," and participated in a combat jump near Sunchon, North Korea. On his return from Korea, he enrolled at The Ohio State University, where he met Dee. A ride in the jumpseat of a Triumph TR3 sealed the deal for Dee and they were married soon after.

As Joe worked his way up through the lumber industry, they built a home in Muirfield Village, the newest development in Dublin, OH, and home to a Jack Nicklaus golf course that would later play

host to U.S. Amateurs, U.S. Junior Amateurs, Ryder Cups, and Solheim Cups. Muirfield hosts the Memorial each year, a regular event on the PGA schedule. While golf was a regular event with the Sullivans, Dee took a step further and lent her talents to the LPGA Borden Classic in Dublin, an LPGA tour event during the '60s and '70s. In addition to her hospitality committee duties, she served as a scorer for many years. Some readers may recall the days of the Bausch and Lomb tennis tournament held at Racquet Park, being close to tennis

greats such as Martina Navratilova, Chris Evert, and Stefi Graf. It was similar for Dee being around the LPGA greats like Joann Carner, Jan Stephenson, Nancy Lopez, and Amy Alcott.

Joe's lumber business had him traveling and doing business with timber companies throughout the southeast. One such trip brought him and Dee close to Amelia Island, where they spent a dark and stormy weekend in the late '80s. From a first-floor Sea Dunes condominium, looking out over a boiling, nor'easter-fed ocean, Dee Sullivan declared, "I love it! This is where we should retire."

But retirement just means you move from what you *have* to do to have a life to doing what you *want* to do to live a life. The Sullivans, being avid golfers, enjoyed their rounds at area courses, but a friendship with Lloyd Hackman and new golf technology would change all that. Joe and Lloyd, along with up-and-coming club engineer and designer Tom Stites, would create a device to accurately measure club shaft frequency, thereby providing touring professionals with increased distance and accuracy.

Golf club technology was on the brink of an explosive shift in equipment in the late '80s and '90s. During that time, professional players began experimenting with metal woods, Lee Trevino winning the 1984 PGA Championship with a metal head driver. Experiments with graphite and fiberglass shafts were also taking place but with limited use as the price of graphite/fiberglass compared to steel at the time made it cost-prohibitive. Engineering advancements with composite materials during the late '80s into the '90s reduced the cost of composite shafts providing avid golfers with a lighter weight club (increased clubhead speed) and increased distance. But those gains were not uniform across the board. This is how Joe Sullivan became one of the most knowledgeable club fitters in the area.

Even the non-engineering and non-golf folks out there may be interested in how it works. If you imagine a golf swing, the clubhead goes back behind the shoulders, and then transitions as the golfer starts to move the clubhead downward. As the clubhead

begins to move downward, this starting motion causes flex in the shaft. With steel shafts, though this flex occurred with a fair bit of uniformity, it was limited. The newer composite shafts flex in all manners and ways. The kick point of the shaft (the location where the clubhead snaps around) can occur at different points along the shaft, either at the very end where the clubhead is, in the middle, or up high near the grip. Each shaft manufacturer measures these locations and shaft flexes differently. The shaft also oscillates as it moves through the golf swing arch. These oscillations of the golf shaft through the swing are measured as cycles per minute (CPM). As we all know, each golfer's swing is unique to the individual.

Enter Joe Sullivan, Lloyd Hackman of Lotus Golf and Tom Stites of Nike Golf. They brought the technology of measuring shaft frequency (CPM) to the golf club fitting process back in the late '80s into the '90s, with Lloyd Hackman and Lotus Golf holding the patents for the fitting technology today. Using the "Iron Byron," a first-generation swing/ ball measuring device, the group determined that there was a wide frequency variation within a golf shaft's classification. Within a shaft class (stiff, regular, or ladies), there could be up to a 40 CPM variation due to manufacturing oversight or lack thereof. The higher a shaft's frequency (270, 290, 310 CPM), the stiffer the shaft; conversely, the lower the number, the more flex a shaft provides. By pairing shaft frequency to the swing speed and tempo of the golfer, plus pinpoint graphing of swing speed, Joe can dial in a shaft and club head combination to maximize the swing of advanced golfers looking for that slight edge.

A former PGA professional recently set a new course record at Long Point with reshafted clubs specific to his swing tempo courtesy of Joe Sullivan. That kind of score also requires great putting, but it starts with putting the ball in the fairway.

With age taking its toll and supply chain difficulties, Joe rarely takes on new shaft replacement projects. Because of golf's seemingly unending obsession with distance and how to squeeze those extra five yards into a tee shot, Joe Sullivan seems content with ending on a high note, having fit area professionals and advanced amateurs. If you find a club fitter willing to use dynamic frequency in the club fitting process, consider it a leg up on the competition, and you can thank Joe Sullivan.





James Joyce






Tana French

Coco is the 9-and-a-half-year-old Newfoundland "dog daughter" of AIP residents Jenny and Doug Nelson, the third "Newfie" they have had. Adopted from a breeder in Wisconsin, she was chocolate brown as a puppy, thus the name Coco. The Nelsons call her a rescue because the breeder had irresponsible practices leading to parasites and long-term health issues for the puppy. The Nelsons love, kindness, knowledge, nurturing, and sheer tenacity helped Coco to become a happy, gentle, and loving "Newfie."

Newfoundlands are known as the world's most powerful water dogs genuine canine swimming champs. The breed was originally developed in Newfoundland, Canada, to aid fishers by pulling boats, hauling nets, and performing water rescue. They use a breaststroke style, rather than a "doggie paddle," which enables them to swim underwater, so vital to water rescue. Their web feet facilitate swimming, and the flat, water-resistant, double coat protects them in cold water.

Surprising Foods that Boost Iron Levels

For many, it manifests as persistent exhaustion and fatigue, headaches, and / or never quite shaking off that winter cold. For others, it can mean hair loss, dizziness upon standing, ringing ears, and even swollen tongue, and depression and anxiety. No, it's not the newest variant of Covid we're concerned with here...

Anemia is a condition that occurs when our bodies don't get enough iron, a crucial component of red blood cells responsible for transporting oxygen from the lungs and throughout the body. A lack of hemoglobin due to inadequate iron levels can wreak havoc on our bodies and minds.

Anemia is actually the most common blood disorder in the U.S., impacting up to 3 million Americans each year. According to the CDC, childbearing women (up to age 50), in particular, should be mindful of iron consumption, as they require 18 mg daily, and up to 27 mg when pregnant. Men, on the other hand, require around 8 mg daily.

Looking to boost your iron intake but not thrilled about the conventional recommendation of red meat, red meat, and more red meat? Try these foods, instead!

Dark, leafy greens: Think spinach, kale, collards ... these delicious leafy greens pack a punch, with just one cup - prepared any way you like delivering up to 30% of our daily recommended iron intake (with bonuses of protein, fiber, calcium, and vitamins A and E!).

Legumes / beans (all kinds): They're not just good for your heart (haha)! The legume family is comprised of a variety of versatile, tasty, and ironpacked options, including soybeans (tofu and tempeh included), white beans, lentils, chickpeas, black beans, and pintos.

Eggs: This breakfast staple, particularly the yolk, is a great source of iron, protein, and vitamins A and D, offering around 1 mg of iron per medium egg. For maximum absorption, try consuming food or drink high vitamin C in the same meal (e.g., orange juice, fresh fruits).

Oysters / mussels: Just 3 ounces of these superstar sea creatures contain 8 mg of iron, a significant percentage of our daily required iron. Pro tip: Squeeze a lemon over your seafood for a pop of Vitamin C, which aids in iron absorption.

Dark chocolate: What a sweet surprise! Three ounces of real (45% or higher cacao) dark chocolate (about one small bar) provide around 7-8 mg of iron, along with an ever-helpful boost of fiber, magnesium, copper, and manganese.


